



IMPORTANT: Election Information Precinct Changes for 2016

Northville Township voters will notice minor precinct changes when they go to the polls in 2016.

After careful review and analysis, the township's Election Commission submitted and received approval to permanently consolidate precincts from 16 down to 12 precincts. Each consolidated precinct remains well under the maximum number of voters, per precinct, permitted under State Law. The consolidation will result in savings at each election and substantially reduce the township's financial obligation to replace the election equipment, which will be required in 2017.

For the majority of voters affected by the consolidation, only the Precinct NUMBER changed and most voters will continue to vote at the same location where they previously voted. However, the **KINGS MILL** voting location has been eliminated and residents of Kings Mill are now assigned to vote at Township Hall. The Kings Mill precinct number remains the same, Precinct #5.

The Clerk, Sue Hillebrand, urges voters to watch for "**IMPORTANT Election Information**" that will be arriving in voter's mailboxes in early January. This envelope will contain the voter's **new ID Card** and a letter explaining the changes which will take effect in 2016.

The Clerk would also like to remind voters that they can be placed on the township's PAL List (Permanent Absentee List). Voters on this list receive an **APPLICATION** (to request an absentee ballot) prior to every election conducted in Northville Township. Anyone can sign up for the PAL, there are no restrictions to sign up. In order to receive an absentee ballot you must complete, check a reason, sign, and return the application form. You are not required to vote absentee if you are on the PAL list.

In mid-January, a new interactive precinct map will be available on the township's website: www.northvillemich.com on the Clerk's page. You can input your address and find out where you vote. Also posted on the Clerk's page, 45 days prior to every election, is a sample ballot of the upcoming election and the unofficial election results are posted on election night.
